

## **AIBA Competitions Bidding Process and Assessment**


AIBA adopts a full-cycle management approach to ensure that AIBA Competitions bidding process and assessment are in line with AIBA Statues, Codes, Rules and Regulations, as well as, the Sustainability Policy and the Conflict of Interest Policy.

In AIBA's vision, sustainability is a way of working. It shall not be an add-on to the operation of events. To ensure effectiveness and efficiency in event planning and operation, we not only reduce unnecessary waste of resources, but also increase the profitability of AIBA events. In other words, AIBA and its Organizing Committees contribute to shape the future of our society by managing our events more effectively.

The bidding process commences when AIBA Headquarters extend the invitations of bid to Member Federations. AIBA Sport will conduct the eligibility assessment of the bids after receiving the required documents (i.e. letter of intent, bid book, other supporting documents) following compliance assessment, risk assessment and technical capacity evaluation. For some events or when the bidding is highly competitive, site visits by a bid evaluation committee may be required to complete the assessment.

A shortlist of bids upon the conclusion of the assessment will be provided to the AIBA Executive Committee and the eligible bidding Member Federations will be invited to present the bids to the AIBA Executive Committee. It is at AIBA Executive Committee's sole discretion to decide to whom to award the event.
